Ron Borzekowski has worked at the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau since early 2011 and is currently the deputy assistant director for the Office of Research. In this role, he directs the office as it supports the policy and research functions of the Bureau. Borzekowski previously served as deputy research director for the Financial Crisis Inquiry Commission and as a senior economist at the Federal Reserve Board. His own research examines consumer financial services, developments in the payments industry (most notably the rapid rise of debit card use in the US), the adoption and impact of new technologies, and the strategic interactions among financial institutions. He received an MPP from the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and a PhD in economics from Stanford University.

His research and teaching focuses on investments, financial institutions and real estate finance. He has published articles in Journal of Finance, Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis, Journal of Business, Journal of Financial Services Research, Real Estate Economics, Journal of Housing Economics and other journals. Professor Sanders has received six teaching awards and three research awards. He serves as associate editor for several leading journals. He has given presentations to the Federal Reserve of Cleveland, Bank of England, European Central Bank in Frankfurt, Bank of Japan as well as academic and executive education presentations in Australia, Chile, Italy, Germany, UK, Japan, China, Poland, Mexico, South Africa and the USA.

Professor Zywicki has testified before Congress on consumer bankruptcy and consumer credit. He is a co-author of the recently published book, Consumer Credit and the American Economy, which examines the economics, behavioral science, sociology, history, institutions, law, and regulation of consumer credit in the United States.

He writes for the legal blog the Volokh Conspiracy and is the co-editor of the Supreme Court Economic Review.

Professor Zywicki received his JD from the University of Virginia, his MA in economics from Clemson University, and his BA in economics from Dartmouth College.


